2006 TWU Convention

The TWU's 2006 annual Convention will be held March 6 through March 10 at the Hilton Vancouver Metrotown Hotel, 6083 McKay Street, Burnaby, BC. The Convention will be called to order at 9:30 a.m. on the morning of the 6th.

There will be 118 delegates participating, representing 54 locals. This Convention will mark the participation for the first time of our new locals and delegates from Ontario and Quebec.

Positions up for election at this Convention include the two new Business Agent positions for Scarborough, Ontario and Montreal, Quebec, as well as Vice President, Calgary; Business Agent, Calgary; Business Agent, Edmonton; two Business Agent positions in Burnaby; positions on the Constitution and Finance Committees; Convention Chair and Vice-Chair; and Pension Trustee.

In addition to the elections, there will be a thorough discussion of last year's dispute with Telus, as well as debate and discussion about the future direction of the union.

This should be an interesting and exciting gathering. Members are entitled to attend. But please bear in mind that rank and file members who choose to attend must do so on their own time and only official delegates are entitled to voice and vote at the Convention.
